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"TWO BY TEN" STRATEGY TO HANDLE DIFFICULT STUDENTS


PROTOSTAR - 1 -

Great things are most of the times born from small, insignificant, even chaotic things. Just like a protostar, newly-born star that stems out of dust clouds, our great knowledge starts from small, even chaotic search into matters, until we start to align, organize, and create a massive, shining body of knowledge.

Keep your core hot enough and pace steady enough to develop into fully-fledged star of knowledge and expertise!

HOW TO APPLY "TWO-TO-TEN" STRATEGY?

- Identify your <u>difficult</u>, <u>challenging</u> learners.
- Assign two minutes every day for 10 consecutive days to connect to your difficult/challenging learner.
- It is important to keep it 2 * 10 so that the conversations are consistent, yet short, giving the learner a relief from pressure.
- Do not enforce the topic of the conversation. Just start it wisely, and lead it, as the learner opens the path of communicating with you. Remember: The purpose is to connect with the difficult learner, not to criticize, ridicule, or judge him!
- Try to plan how to meet and speak to the learner. These meetings should not show planning to
 the learner. <u>Plan secretly</u> so that the meeting sounds natural. Otherwise, a learner might tend to
 reject communicating with you.
- Connection must be <u>natural and genuine</u> but not friendly. The thin line between the leanerteacher should remain present for further well-managed classes.
- You may need to <u>keep a record</u> of the conversations and/or incidents before, during, and after the conversations to observe patterns and evaluate the process and its results effectively.



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
